### **1. Authority**

- This event is a Multi-Club Motorkhana conducted on the DECA Shepparton skidpan and parts of their internal roads, held under the National Competition Rules of the Australian Auto Sport Alliance Inc. "AASA". These Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations that may be issued. AASA Permit Number is: TBA

### **2. Entries**

- Faxed entries with Direct Deposit payment Authorization number or a copy of deposit slip will be accepted to fax number **(03) 8872 1394**.
- Cheques can be accepted if sent to Skylines Australia Vic, PO Box 2045, Seaford, Vic 3198
- The SAU committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without explanation.
- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt on a correctly completed entry form.
- No entries shall be accepted from under 14-year-old competitors
- Entry fee is as stated on the entry form (AUD \$75.00) Entries open and close at the times/dates as stated on the entry form.
- Entry is open to members of affiliated car clubs.
- Entrants must produce their club membership card and current AASA or equivalent standard competition licence, Log book (if issued) and competition record at registration on the morning of the event.

### **3. Vehicles**

- Cars presented to the scrutineer not ready for competition will be denied entry to the event.
- Cars must be considered roadworthy and will be subjected to a quick examination.
- Tyres must be roadworthy to enter the road events on the DECA highway circuit

### **4. Apparel**

- Competitors must wear non-flammable clothing. Nylon clothing is not permitted. Shoes must be closed toe.
- Helmets are to be worn during the special road events, but are exempt on the skidpan.

### **5. Event**

- Motorkhana courses will be selected by the Skylines Australia Vic Inc. committee.
- Drivers must obey flags, board signals, and any direction(s) given by our appointed officials.
- Drivers must run in numerical order unless otherwise instructed by an official.
- Protests, if any, must be submitted in writing to the Event Director in accordance with the requirements of SAU Vic Inc.
- Vehicles will not be permitted on the circuit after 4.30pm and must have vacated the complex by 5.00pm.
- One Passenger only will be permitted in vehicles during any part of the Motorkhana or special events. A passenger indemnity form is to be completed prior to the passenger entering the event. Passengers must wear a helmet on the highway circuit.
- A maximum of two vehicles will be allowed onto the road circuit and skidpan at any one time, and must be traveling in the same direction.
- Maximum speed within the complex roads and pits is 10km/h. Please be mindful of spectators.
- No spinning of wheels between events. Offenders will be removed from the complex and competition.
- Further event instructions and scheduled times will be issued to participants prior to the event outlining the day's proceedings. This 'Event Schedule' will include maps of the DECA facilities and current motorkhanas.
